## ALEXANDRIA CITY PUBLIC SCHOOLS EXPANDED SCOPE PROPOSAL

PCG understands that the Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS) is requesting a proposal to extend the scope of the current special education review being conducted. The goal of this expanded review would be to conduct school observations and student shadowing in the remaining eight (8) schools.

## **REVISED TIMELINE**

In preparing this proposal, we assumed the following:

- 2. If deemed necessary by PCG, additional staff may join for data collection at no additional cost.
- 3. Work will be performed on a fixed price basis.
- 4. No more than 5% of scheduled meetings, interviews, forums, or other activities related to information gathering or project management will be cancelled, rescheduled or postponed by ACPS or its identified stakeholder groups. Exceeding this threshold will result in project deliverable delays and may result in additional fees in order to recover time or extend schedule.
- 5. Performing this scope of work would not preclude PCG from any future contracted services.
