- **TOPIC:** Program of Studies for 2015-16 for Secondary Schools

BACKGROUND: February 2, 2015 marks the start of the enrollment process for secondary students for the 2015-16 school year. Students and their families are provided with a Program of Studies that provides information on graduation and school practices that support their learning. The Program of Studies also includes a comprehensive list of courses available to meet graduation requirements, provide opportunities to explore a wide-range of disciplines, and meet diverse student needs and interests.

A committee of administrators and guidance staff from each school of the secondary schools, along with Curriculum & Instruction and Communications staff, worked to design and develop the proposed Program of Studies for the 2015-16 school year. These committee members worked with various departments in each school to solicit recommendations for course revisions, additions and deletions that incorporated trends in student interest and demand, as well as ensuring that the division is meeting new and revised course and graduation requirements from the Virginia Department of Education.

During October and November 2014, the Honors Review committee reviewed the 2014-2015 Program of Studies and made content, language, and course recommendations. The Program of Studies committee received and accepted the majority of the content and language recommendations provided by the Honors Review committee.

The entire proposed Program of Studies is attached for your review. The tables below provide an overview of changes from the previous Program of Studies (2014-15).

Once the Program of Studies is approved, it will be published on the ACPS website and printed in hard copy form for distribution to students, parents/guardians, and school staff at the end of January, as staff members begin to meet students and their parents/guardians to plan for each student's 2015-16 enrollment.
