SCHOOL BUS SCHEDULING AND ROUTING

The operation of school buses is scheduled to maximize safety and efficiency.

School bus routes, school sites and safety of students and designated school bus stops are shall be reviewed at reasonably frequent intervals, but at least once each year for safety hazards and to assure the efficient use of buses and as changes occur. Routes are reviewed for safety hazards, fuel conservation, available human resources (i.e. bus driver staffing) and to assure the most efficient use of buses. School administrators work with the Director of Transportation to evaluate the safety of pupilsstudents at bus stops periodically, and report the results annually to the Alexandria City School Board-annually.

A written vehicular and pedestrian traffic control plan for each school is shall be reviewed annually for safety hazards. All new school site plans shall-include provisions that promote vehicular and pedestrian safety.
