## SUMMARY:

On November 2, 2023, the Superintendent will present the recommended Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget for FY 2025-2034. The Superintendent has prepared a CIP budget that

responds to City guidance while prioritizing as many needs as possible in accordance with the FY2024 Budget Priorities. The adoption of the Capital Improvement Program is an annual commitment to a series of projects with estimated costs based on current knowledge, market conditions, and projects.

The FY 2025-2034 CIP will be discussed at a series of work sessions, with the following proposed dates and agendas (dates subject to change):

- November 13, 2023: CIP Budget Work Session #1
- November 13, 2023: Public Hearing on the FY 2025-2034 CIP Budget
- November 27, 2023: CIP Budget Work Session #2
- December 6, 2023: CIP Add/Delete Work Session #1

- December 14, 2023: Adoption of the FY 2023-2032 CIP Budget

## **BACKGROUND:**

In preparation for the FY 2025-2034 CIP, the School Board discussed and voted on budget priorities to drive the CIP formulation process. The School Board held a Joint Work Session with City Council on November 1, 2023 to discuss ACPS's proposed plan for the CIP.

**RECOMMENDATION:** The Superintendent recommends that the School Board review the CIP presentation materials.

## **IMPACT:**

The capital budget will support ACPS's needs for additional capacity, facilities upgrades, as well as transportation, technology, and textbook modernizations.
