# **Equity Audit of School Board Policies Purpose**

- Ensure each policy aligns, guides, and supports educational equity and the Strategic Plan.
- Specifically identify root causes of disparities.
- Focus on the most marginalized populations to ensure equity for all.
- Uncover and revise policies that thwart the success of historically marginalized groups.
- Dismantle current systems that are barriers to student success.








## ACPS Equity Audit of School Board Policies Process

















# **Policies and Regulations**

- Policy is a <u>basic statement of the intent</u> of the School Board which creates rights and responsibilities for the conduct of the school division's business.
- Regulation is the manner or <u>method of implementation</u> of policy by the Superintendent and staff, subject to change as conditions and/or circumstances may dictate.

# **Essential Questions**

- 1. Do the revisions support Equity for All?
  - Who is the policy intended to impact?
  - Who does it impact?
  - Who is adversely impacted?
  - How do we mitigate the adverse impact?



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- 2. Do the revisions align with the Code of Virginia?
- 3. Do the revisions improve Systemic Alignment?



# **Draft Revisions**

## All Policies and Regulations

- Removed gender affirming terms
- Replaced parent with parent/guardian
- Reduced the use of 'shall' per VSBA model policy changes
- Added breadcrumbs to other policies
- Rewording and reformatting to improve readability
- Aligned content with VSBA model policies and the Code of Virginia



# **Draft Revisions**

## **FA - Facilities Development FA-R - Energy Conservation and Energy Management Regulations**

- 5-year review
- No VSBA Model Policy
- Added reference to Alexandria's 2019 Green Building Policy
- Added breadcrumbs to FB and FEA
- Updated language so it's clear the governance applies to all facilities and staff
- Updated the Unoccupied Cooling Set Point to current practices (80F)
- Clarified rules and approval process for personal appliances



# **Draft Revisions**

**FB** - Facilities Planning **FBA - Community Funded Facilities Projects** FBA-R - Regulations for Community Funded Capital Projects (was FB-R)

- 5-year review
- VSBA Model Policy alignment
- Changed the title from Community Funded Capital Projects to Community Funded Facilities Projects to reflect that not all projects are part of the CIP.
- Moved Community Funded Facilities Projects into a new policy (FBA Community Funded Facilities Projects) and moved the regulation under this new policy. This improves alignment with the VSBA model policy and clarifies the distinction between the two types of projects.



# **Draft Revisions**

FB - Facilities Planning **FBA - Community Funded Facilities Projects** FBA-R - Regulations for Community Funded Capital Projects (was FB-R)

- Continued...
- Removed the committee language to improve flexibility for each project
- Aligned the Regulation with the current process and project classifications
- Removed specific roles from the review process
- Revised the final approval step to align with the three types of projects.

FF - Non-Sponsored Naming and Renaming of School Division Facilities FF-R - Regulations for Non-Sponsored Naming and Renaming of School Division **Facilities** 

## FF-A - Appendix A

- Requested review
- Renumbered to FFA as VSBA's policy FF has different content
- **Standard Changes**
- Added a belief statement
- Reorganized the regulation to improve readability
- Added a new process where the Board has the option to pursue renaming if requested. The current governance is silent on what happens if a request is received.
- Added that any request that does not comply with naming guidelines would not be considered
- Removed examples of the types of names



# **Draft Revisions**

## **FG** - Retirement of Facilities

- 5-year review
- VSBA Model Policy alignment
- Noted that retirement of facilities is part of the CIP process
- Clarified that many ACPS facilities are owned by the city
- Added that any retired facility should be considered for the purpose of supporting students and the community.
