

“Graduation” Analysis

At the request of the School Board, ACPS has prepared the following analysis of graduating options (students potentially exempted from redistricting). Please note the following:

- Each grade level removes the students and their associated siblings accounted for in the graduating analysis of the higher grade level.
- The numbers vary from the original analysis because Administrative Transfers and Capacity Reassignments were taken into account in this analysis.
- Because all data regarding next year’s enrollment, administrative transfers and capacity reassignments are not yet available, some projections were used to determine the impact of next year’s enrollment.

Option 1: Graduate (exempt from redistricting) students who will be 5th graders at the implementation of redistricting along with their siblings and administrative transfers.
