Importance of Athletic Opportunities for Students

Participation in athletics:

- Provides opportunities for lifelong lessons in the value of teamwork, empathy, work ethic, resilience, and sacrifice for a goal; all within the values of respect and honor.
- Builds a foundations for lifelong fitness habits & health benefits.
- Teaches valuable skills in leadership and time management.
- Helps children develop and improve cognitive skills.
- Ability to compare critical performance measures, athlete to non-athlete.

Both male and female high school athletes are less likely to smoke cigarettes and suffer from loneliness and low self-esteem, when compared to non-athlete peers, according to (Women's Sports Foundation, 2018).

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
