Call to Order

1. Meeting Called to Order by Chair Anderson

They have worked for the past year with the Strategic Planning Committee to draft a five-year strategic plan for ACPS through 2025. The draft plan will be presented in two parts. In this first presentation, Dr. Joftus highlighted the key principles in the development of the plan, the work of the Strategic Planning Committee, the plan's framework and the vision, mission, and core values that were developed by the School Board.

Board Members commented that they were excited about the new Strategic Plan and thanked the planning committee members, staff and the FourPoint team for their hard work on the plan.

The second part of the Draft Strategic Plan is scheduled to be presented on May 29, 2020 and will focus on the specific goals within the plan, associated measures designed to determine the extent to which goals are being implemented, and the strategies and highlighted actions to help achieve each goal.
