

- Finishing up pilot project for Virginia Victimization Screening Tool in conjunction with Center for Alexandria's Children. Hope our contribution helped to create a better assessment tool.

- Teen Wellness Center is in alignment with ACAP's plan to install condom dispensers throughout the City. They are still working on their communications plan before implementation. They have agreed to include TWC messaging on the dispensers to encourage teens who take advantage of the free condoms to come to TWC for more information, evaluation, and education.
