Priority Focus Areas - Goals

Academic Achievement

Priority 1: Tier I Instruction: Alignment, Rigor, Engagement

By June 2024, ACPS will improve Tier I instruction through an aligned written, taught, and assessed curriculum as measured by a 5 percentage point increase in SOL Annual Pass Rate data.

Student Supports

Priority 1: CASEL Social Emotional Learning Competencies

By June 2024, ACPS will increase CASEL competencies of social awareness (54% spring 2023) to 60% and self management (61% spring 2023) to 65% through the use of Ruler lessons implemented during the scheduled allotted weekly SEAL time with quality for all students as measured by DESSA and RULER Walkthrough forms.

Staff Supports

Priority 1: Continue Culture Building

By June 2024, All CO school-assigned liaisons will participate in school meetings and events monthly to support school leaders and ACPS priorities.

Academic Achievement

Priority 2: The High School Project

By June 2024, ACPS will have:
Construction at substantial completion for facility
Completed educational programs and studies
Completed schedules for teachers and students

Student Supports

Priority 2: Student Connection and Attendance

By June 2024, ACPS will achieve a decrease in chronic absenteeism by 20% for all identified groups.
(Percentage points to vary by groups...ex: EL 25% Chronic Abs in 22-23 goal would be 20% SY 23-24 vs. White 10% Chronic Abs in 22-23 goal would be 8% in SY 23-24)

By June 2024, ACPS will develop a staff support program for new and existing staff that will provide quarterly resources to increase retention rates.
