



Review current School Board policies to:


- Ensure each policy aligns, guides, and supports educational equity and the Strategic Plan.
- Specifically identify root causes of disparities.
- Focus on the most marginalized populations to ensure equity for all.
- Uncover and revise policies that thwart the success of historically marginalized groups.
- Dismantle current systems that are barriers to student success.

Phase II: SY 2021-22

- Committee review and policy revision
- Community engagement with ACPS stakeholders
- Refine and adopt policy revisions
- Review of Tier II policies

Phase III

- Action planning, implementation & capacity building
- Development of 5-year outlook and plan for re-evaluation



School Board Committee

- October 7, 2021: Equity Policy Audit School Board Committee created; Board Members appointed to serve first rotation
- Committee performs in-depth policy review; monthly meetings
- Recommendations presented to full Board for review/ approval
- School Board Chair periodically recommends three Board Members for appointment to serve during next rotation
 - Dynamic, inclusive process; adjustments made as needed
