To delay that discussion would be to ignore the fact that we are experiencing an inflection point in our history about how we will deal with race as we move forward. The discussion of whether our high school should continue to be named after a man whose chief legacy appears to be acting as a roadblock to integration should be had at the same time that our society is discussing the broader movement of Black Lives Matter. These two issues go hand in hand. And to put the discussion off for another year dismisses the portion of our community that grieves over injustice. It sidelines their complaint and tells them they can live with the travesty for one more year. Justice delayed is justice denied. Every single one of us has likely asked ourselves what we would have done if we had lived through a particular moral crisis in history. That question is no longer theoretical. We are living through that moment right now and each of us, including our elected leaders on this Board must ask themselves what part they can play in this moral moment in time.
