TOPIC:	Athletic Hall of Fame Advisory Committee 2018-2019 End of Year Report

BACKGROUND: At the conclusion of school year (SY) 2013-2014, the Alexandria City School Board approved the organization of a committee tasked to establish an Athletic Hall of Fame (AHOF) for the purpose of recognizing outstanding alumni athletes from current and former ACPS high schools. The committee developed the nomination and selection criteria to recognize athletes and held its first induction ceremony in December 2014. Since that time, the Athletic Hall of Fame Advisory Committee has held five annual ceremonies, inducting 51 athletes and honorees as of June 2019. The Athletic Hall of Fame plaques are displayed at T.C. Williams High School in the hallway outside the Gerry Bertier Gymnasium.

SUMMARY:

On November 2, 2018 the school division inducted the athletes and coaches approved at the June 7, 2018 School Board Meeting into the ACPS Athletic Hall of Fame. These inductees were:

The School Board reviewed these nominations at its May 23, 2019 School Board Meeting and unanimously approved the inductees at the June 6, 2019 School Board Meeting. The induction ceremony will be held on October 4, 2019 at T.C. Williams High School to coincide with Homecoming. The event includes a "Meet and Greet" in the gymnasium, followed by a ceremony where the new inductees will be presented with replicas of their plaques. Afterwards, the official plaques will be unveiled by the inductees in the lobby outside of the gymnasium. After this group of athletes and coaches are inducted there will be 61 members of the ACPS Athletic Hall of Fame.

The School Board approved the AHOF bylaws at its December 18, 2018 School Board Meeting, which reinforced the committee structure and nomination criteria for the selection of inductees. Since that time, the AHOF Committee has decided to further revise its bylaws for clarification and will be submitting these revisions for approval during the 2019-2020 school year.
