





- During the 2022-2023 school year, NOVA's HSDE program offered in partnership with Alexandria City Public Schools resulted in an effective scholarship for City of Alexandria families of over \$1,000,000
- Enrollment in the program grew more than 27% between Fall 2021 and Fall 2022






