## **Update shared with principals in WWW on June 15, 2022:**

The ACPS website redesign project is nearing its launch on July 1, 2022, at which time the school division's website, as well as the websites of all ACPS schools will feature a new design. Our team has been migrating content from the google docs that school principals and department heads reviewed and updated, as well as copy editing that content – this has ensured that the content being migrated is accurate, consistent and clear across the division and school webpages.

The communications team will continue to upload content throughout the summer, across the division and school websites, to ensure all relevant content is posted by the start of the new school year in August.

Monitoring and editing of website content will be ongoing. For the website launch, we have developed a google form for staff to inform us of any issues that you come across such as missing web pages, web pages in the wrong place, content missing from a web page, issues with formatting, etc. This form can be found here: ACPS Web Launch Feedback Form.

During the weeks of June 20-30, we will share a link to the new website with you, so you can have a first look at the website before the public launch on July 1, 2022. As of June 20 and going forward, please use the web launch feedback form to alert us of any issues you may see (note that this form will not be usable until you've been provided with the link to the new website). These will be addressed in as timely a manner as possible. If you haven't already done so, please complete this form to provide us with the names of individuals who will have website editing privileges for your department/school.

We ask that every department and school identify at least one person to receive training in how to update and maintain the school website or department web pages since this routine maintenance will be the responsibility of each school and department; you are welcome to assign more than one person for web editing training. This summer, website editors will be provided training and access to the Finalsite CMS. Our team will continue to be a resource to principals and directors when new web pages need to be created or there is a need that is outside of routine updating and maintenance; also, we are available at all times to provide support and refresher training to anyone who needs it. Throughout the summer, we will finalize the migration of content onto the new website, develop FAQs, and provide training resources.
