As part of the Board’s continuing, five-year policy review cycle, five policies and regulations from the classifications below are proposed for revision:

B Policies: School Board Governance and Operations

E Policies: Support Services

J Policies: Students

The proposed revisions reflect statutory changes taking effect for the 2021-22 school year or current ACPS practice.
