School Board Member Roles & Responsibilities



Board Member Roles

- Oversight (Board) vs. Day-to-Day Operations (Superintendent)
- Liaison to Advisory Committees and Schools
- School Board Operates as a Continuous Body
 - No Individual Board Member Authority



Board Member Roles

- Board Members are Officers of the State
 - Standards of Conduct & Code of Ethics
 - Confidentiality
 - Conflicts of Interest
 - Nepotism
 - Legal Requirement for Impartiality re: Staff & Students
 - Compensation
- Communicating with the Public, Media & Staff
 - Individual Board Member Legal Liability

Board Member Responsibilities

- Commitment to Serve Alexandria's Students & Families
- Oversight of School Division
- Policy
- Annual Capital and Operating Budgets
- Obtain Public Comment

Board Member Responsibilities

- Appoint & Annually Evaluate Superintendent
- Meeting Preparation & Agendas

School Board Policies Regarding Campaigns



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Essential Questions

- <u>Policy GBG/KE</u>: Staff Participation in Political Activities and School Board Election Campaigns
 - ACPS does not support or oppose any candidate or give the impression that it does
 - Staff time may not be used to support/oppose campaigns (during work hours)
 - School division resources may not be used to support/oppose campaigns
 - ACPS website, email, logos, social media platforms, and TV station may not be used to support/oppose campaigns

• <u>Policy KF:</u> Distribution of Information/Materials

- - Prohibits distribution of campaign materials on school property
- <u>Regulation KG-R:</u> Community Use of School Facilities
 - Candidates may use school facilities outside of school hours when available (facilities use fees apply)
- <u>Policy KJ:</u> Advertising in the Schools

Essential Questions

• Prohibits use of pictures involving ACPS staff, students or facilities to promote any candidate
