

LOCALLY AWARDED VERIFIED CREDIT REGULATIONS

Panel members will consist of:

- (1) The T.C. Williams test coordinator or representative of the Department of Accountability;
- (2) The Director of Counseling and the appropriate counselor;
- (3) The ~~Dean of Students~~ student's administrator, ~~high~~-school principal, and the Executive Director of Secondary Instruction.

Whenever a Special Permission Credit Accommodation is being considered, the Executive Director of Specialized Instruction will be included on the panel.

Information to be collected and presented by the student's counselor to the panel will include:

- (1) Classroom assignments;
- (2) Course grade(s); and
- (3) Papers, projects, essays, and written assignments.

The panel should take into consideration that a student might not have kept assignments from a teacher. Failure to provide (1) or (3) above will not exclude a student from receiving the credit. However, the panel may require additional academic assignments or testing to determine adequate knowledge of Standards of Learning content.
