

ADVANCED PLACEMENT AND DUAL ENROLLMENT CLASSES

ACPS shall notify students and their parents/guardians of the availability of dual-enrollment and Advanced Placement classes, the qualifications for enrolling in such classes, and the requirement that all students enrolled in Advanced Placement classes take the examination in order to receive additional grade-point average quality points. Students in dual-enrollment classes must earn a passing grade in order to receive additional grade-point average quality points.

Students and their parents/guardians shall also be notified in the ACPS Program of Studies of division-approved programs with community colleges to enable the students to complete an Associate's Degree or a one-year Uniform Certificate of General Studies concurrent with the high school diploma.

The School Board will fully fund the cost of such examinations. The Superintendent shall promulgate regulations to implement this policy, which shall ensure the provision of timely and adequate notice to students and their parents/guardians.
