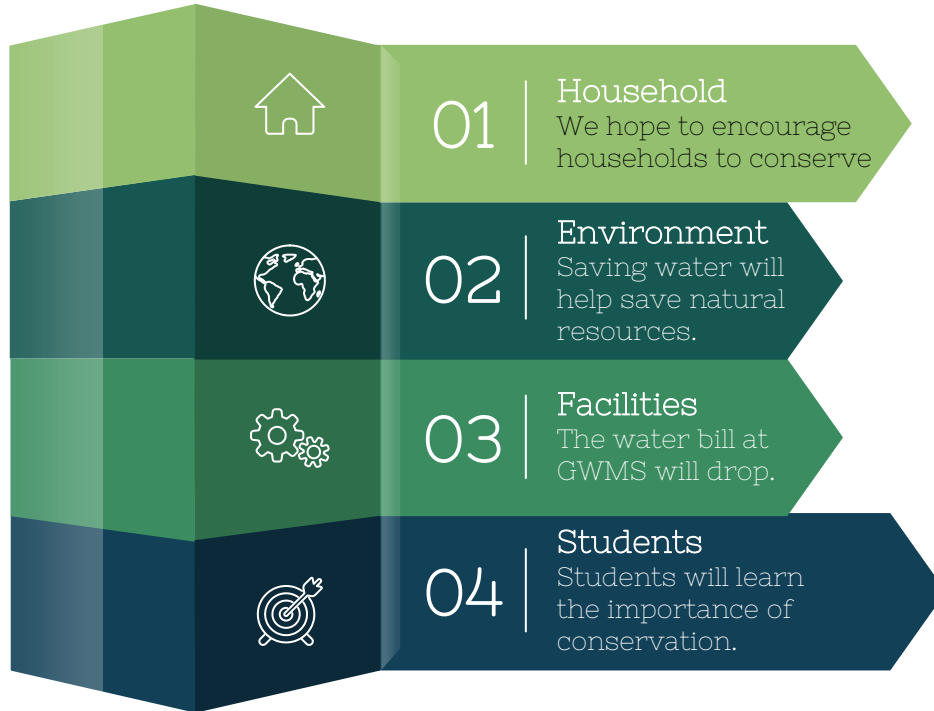

That's a lot of water saved!



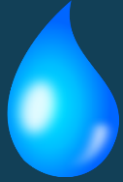
1,500 users per day

And a lot of users!



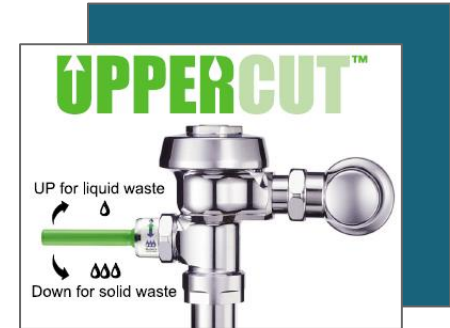
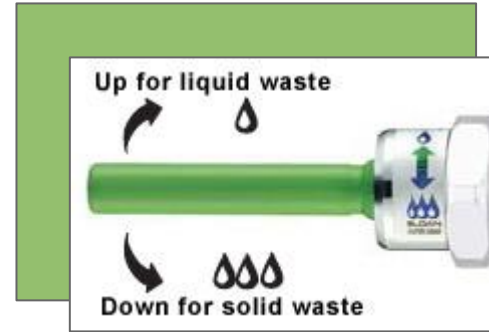

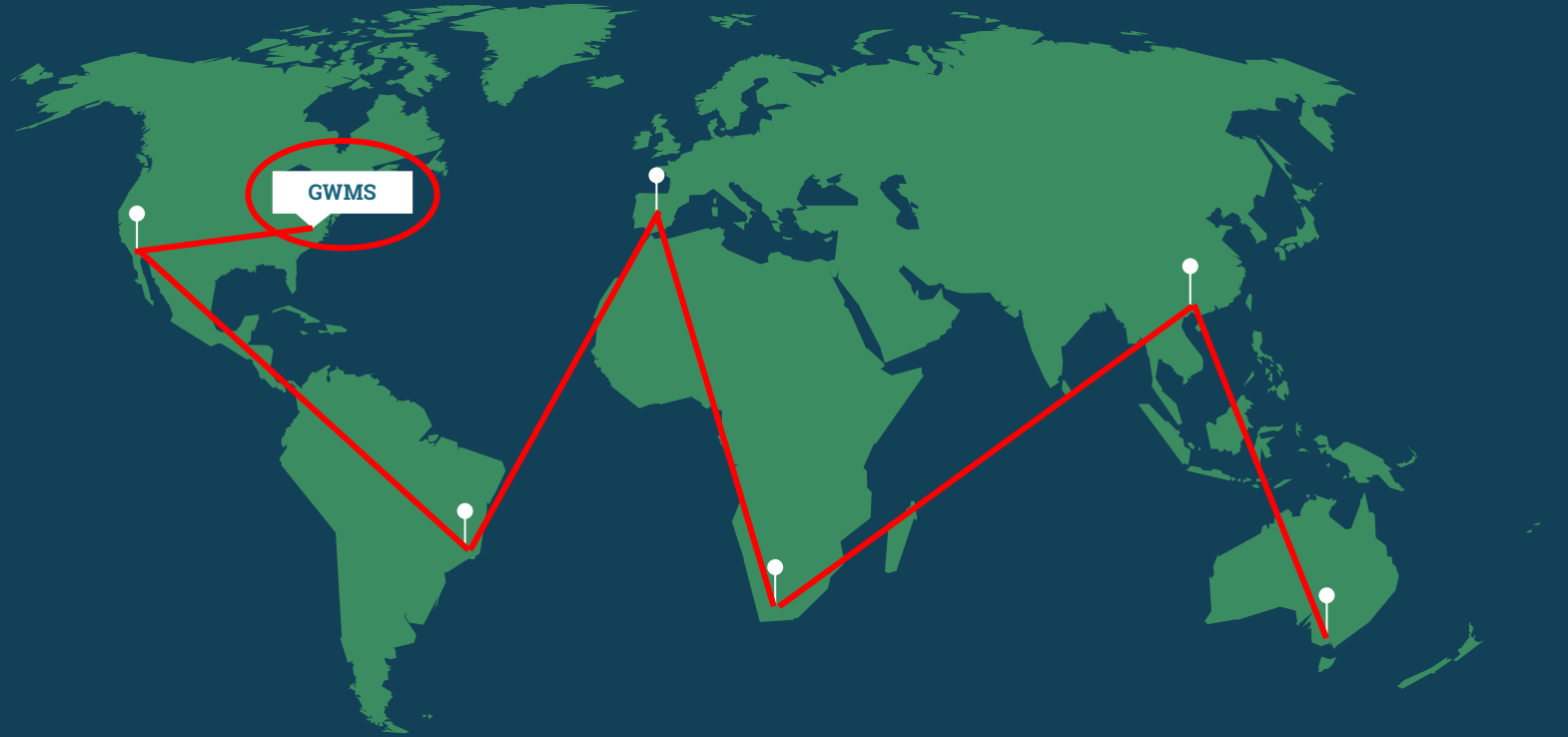
