- 1. Discuss areas of focus of the subcommittee
  - a. Reviewed quick agenda, Lauren here for support
  - b. Sandra said many work placements have shut down with the pandemic; the nature of transition services is changing; Project SEARCH is still there, but was shut down for a year; wondering about post-pandemic focus
  - c. Janet is concerned about the life skills portion of planning that is not occurring in the pandemic—riding the bus, grocery shopping, etc. Not happening now.
