SUMMARY:

On April 5, 2021, the AHOF Advisory Committee met to begin the evaluation of nomination forms for selection of the members of the 2021 ACPS Athletic Hall of Fame. The committee formed subcommittees to evaluate nominees in specific athletic groups which made recommendations to the full committee for final evaluation. At the May 24, 2021 meeting the AHOF Advisory Committee, by overwhelming consensus, selected the following members for induction into the ACPS Athletic Hall of Fame for 2021:

The AHOF Induction Ceremony has not been scheduled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, however, the

induction event for the 2020 and 2021 Athletic Hall of Fame Inductees is expected to take place in the Fall of 2021. The event includes a reception and ceremony followed by the unveiling of plaques.

BACKGROUND:

In February 2014, the Alexandria City School Board formed the Athletic Hall of Fame Advisory Committee in response to numerous requests to memorialize outstanding student athletes, and to inspire current students to strive for excellence. Since that time, there have been 51 inductees into the ACPS Athletic Hall of Fame.

Each year, the Alexandria City School Board's Athletic Hall of Fame Advisory Committee reviews community nominations of deserving high school athletes, teams, coaches and non-athlete contributors for inclusion in the ACPS Athletic Hall of Fame. Nominees are selected based on their athletic accomplishments in high school, college and beyond, as well as their impact or contribution to the community at large.
