

- Outlines schedule possibilities at all grade levels
- Links school-based learning with the knowledge and skills required for success in the workplace
- Offers steps for academic and career planning for grades 6-12
- Includes course requirements and expectations
- Defines graduation requirements
- Provides information about academies (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics, International Academy, Health Sciences Academy, Academy of Finance)
- Lists support offered to students
- Provides students and families with a list of course offerings
