SUMMARY:

nights. Back-to-School Night serves to facilitate home-school collaboration through sharing information, building relationships, addressing questions and concerns, and promoting parent engagement.

DETAILS:

The schedule in the following table reflects alternating dates for elementary and middle schools on opposite ends of the city to (1) minimize conflicts for parents/guardians attending at both the elementary and secondary levels, and (2) streamline the provision of interpretation services.

BACKGROUND:

Each year, back-to-school night events are scheduled within the first month of school. On these nights, parents/guardians are invited to meet the teachers and staff at each school, learn about their student(s)' classes, and engage in discussions about the curriculum. Parent/Guardian outreach is done at both the division and school levels, and interpretation services are provided. In addition, ACPS carefully reviews observed holidays to avoid any conflict.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Superintendent recommends that the School Board review the information in this board brief regarding 2024–2025 ACPS back-to-school nights.

IMPACT:

The dates for the ACPS 2024–2025 back-to-school nights have been spread out to increase parent/guardian participation and improve accessibility to interpretation services.
