Infrastructure

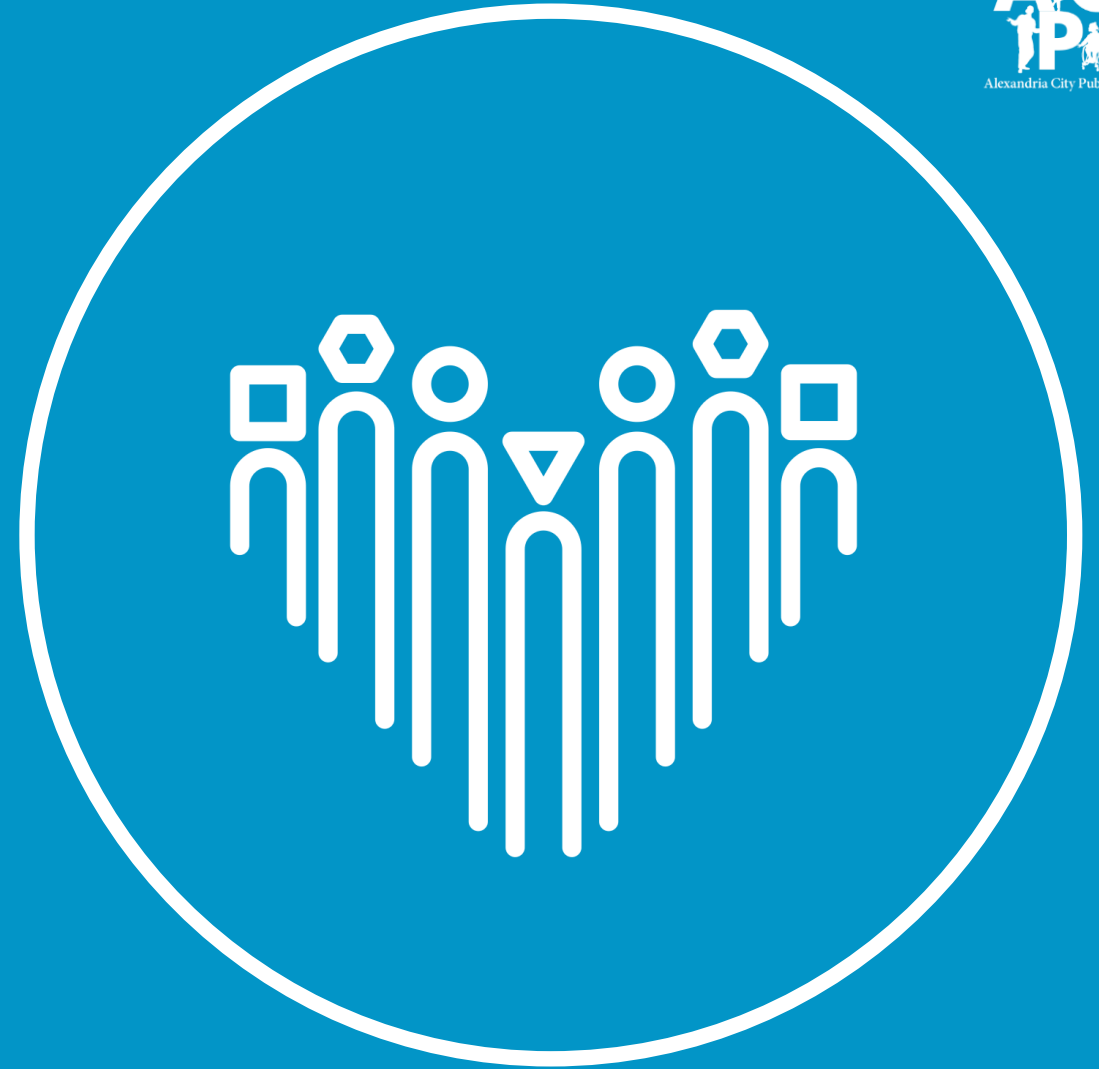

Instructional Technology Tool Types



Infrastructure Status Update

- Funds allocated for infrastructure projects during the pandemic were reallocated to purchase and support student/staff devices, home internet access and hybrid learning
- New challenges due to COVID:
 - Increase in operational and instructional applications acquired
 - Additional 4,000 devices to manage
 - Reactivation of dormant network equipment
 - Restarting projects delayed by 18 months
 - Continued delays with supply chain and available contract work
- Infrastructure projects are currently a priority and a reality through the Elementary and Secondary Schools Emergency Relief fund



Completed* & Current Projects

- New Helpdesk software/ticketing system (3.2)*
- Building PA System Audit (3.4)*
- Upgraded Security for ACHS Staff and Student Network (3.4), (3.2)
- Installed Distributed Antenna System (DAS) at ACHS (3.4), (3.3), (3.4)
- Installation of Zoom Phone (3.4)
- Classroom camera installation (3.1)



Essential COVID Infrastructure Projects

- Provided internet access for over 2,000 students
- Created a virtual help desk to support the community in the spring of 2020
- Expanded staff and student helpdesk to provide family in-person helpdesk
- Completed over 40,000 helpdesk tickets submitted by staff and families
- Acquired applications and created systems for tracking COVID cases and daily symptoms, providing local reporting to Alexandria Health Department, collecting family preferences, and publishing a publicly viewable dashboard.



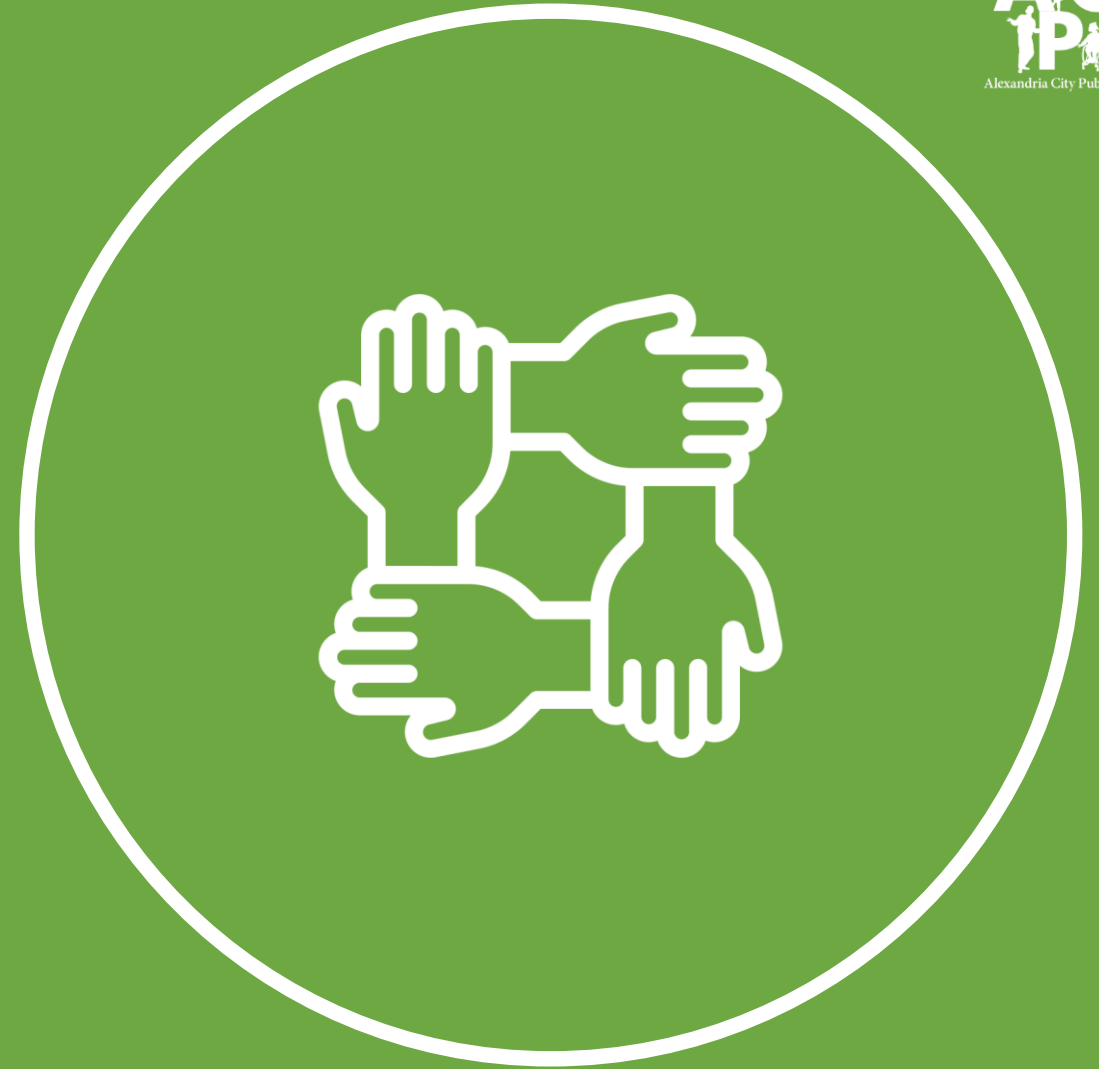
