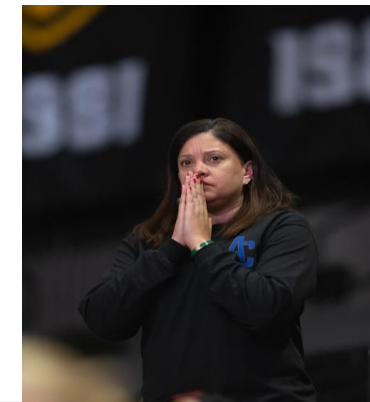

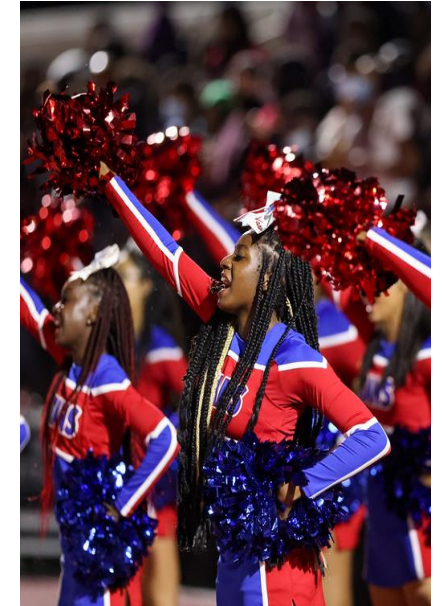

Athletic Department Innovation

Creation of an Athletic Academic Achievement Award Program

Academic Achievement Award (Seasonal)

Awarded to student-athletes that ends the season in good standing and maintains a 3.5 GPA

Scholar Athlete Award (Seasonal/Varsity Only)

Awarded to the student-athlete on each varsity team with the highest GPA

Team Academic Excellence Award (Seasonal/Yearly)

Awarded to the varsity team, one per gender, with the highest team GPA per season
Awarded to the varsity team with the highest team GPA during the full school year

Golden Titan Award (Senior/Yearly)

Awarded to the senior athlete with the highest GPA
