

MOU SRO Quarterly Performance Report April 2022

Overview

Quarterly meetings between Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS) and the Alexandria Police Department (APD) are required as part of the SLEP Memorandum of Understanding (November 2020). Meetings are to occur August, November, February and May; in this school year, SRO's did not return to ACPS campuses until October 2021 and thus the meeting schedule has been slightly adjusted, with the most recent meeting occurring on Thursday, March 17, 2022. The next meeting will occur in May 2022.

After each quarterly meeting, a subsequent report is to be completed and shared to provide updates on:

- **Section I: VDOE Annual Discipline, Crime and Violence Report.** As noted in the June 2021 SRO Quarterly Update, the annual VDOE Discipline, Crime and Violence report has been replaced by the VDOE Student Behavior Administrative Response (SBAR) report. SBAR incidents are recorded through the end of the school year. A preliminary SBAR report was submitted to VDOE in March. The final report will be submitted in July. The annual report will be made available publicly by VDOE. If there are any questions on this item, please contact the Department of Student Services and Equity.
- **Section II: Police Statistical Reports.** This information is in relation to the Calls for Service form; more details on this item noted later in this document.
- **Section III: VDOE School Climate Survey.** This information is in relation to the required Code of Virginia School Safety Survey that is completed annually.
- **Section IV: School Resource Officer (SRO) Performance Items.** This information includes SRO attendance and incident reporting.
- **Section V: Educational Activities with Students:** This information includes any educational offerings by SRO's for students.

Section II: Police Statistical Reports

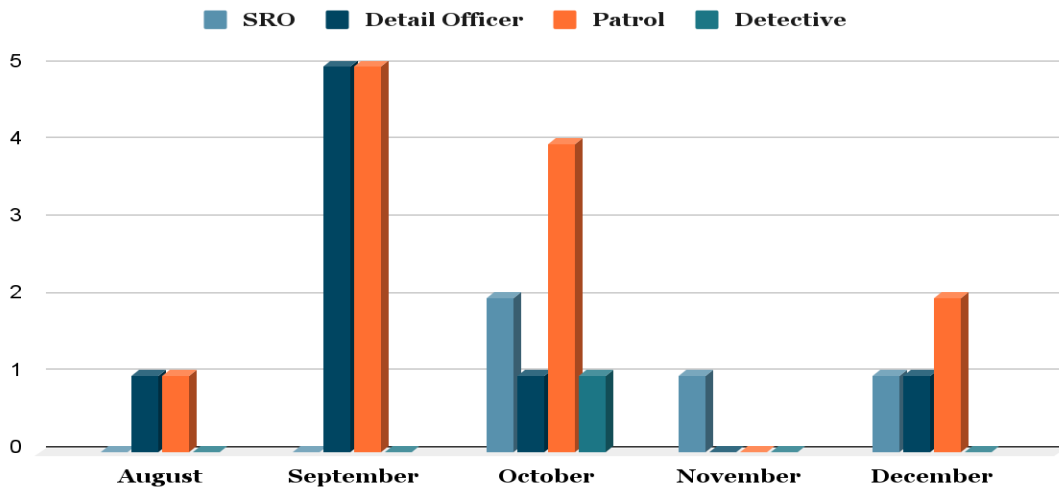

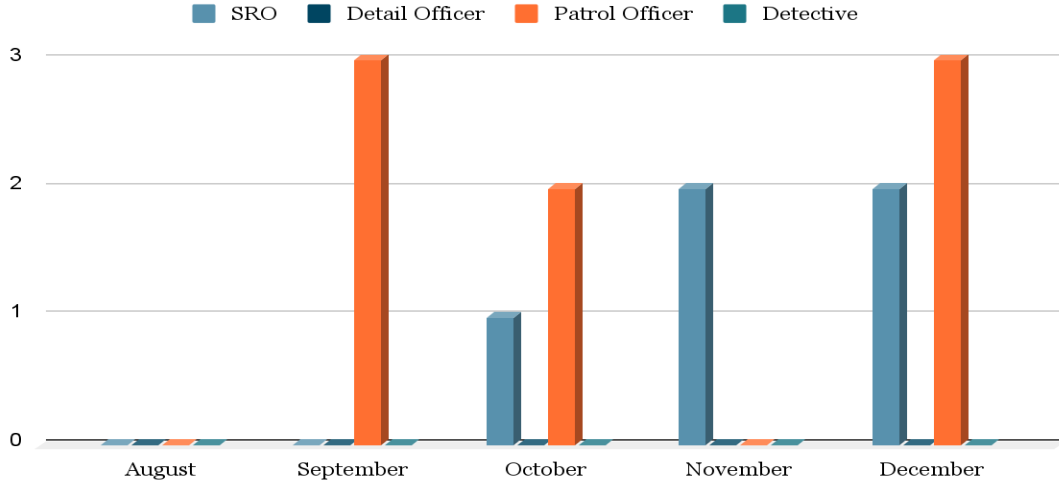

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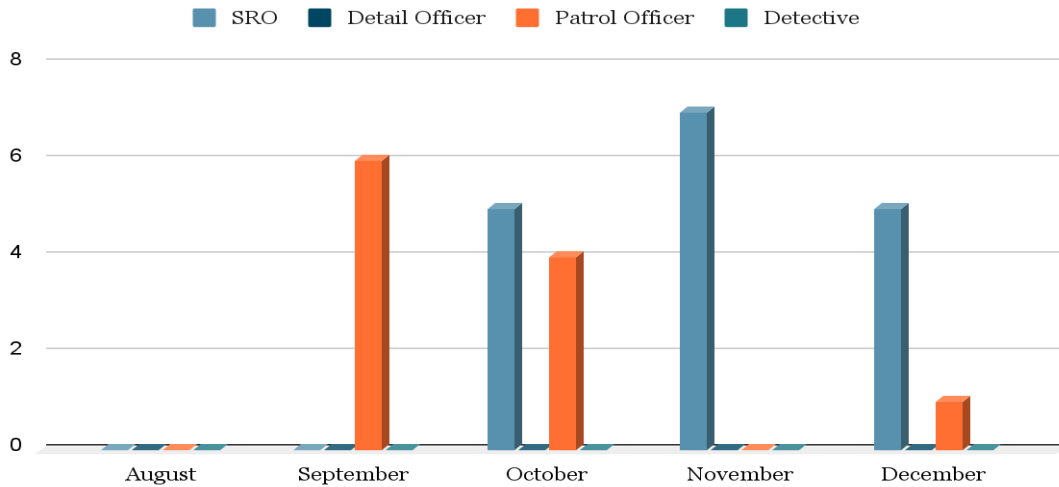
ACHS-MH Calls for Service Summary

George Washington MS- Calls for Service Summary

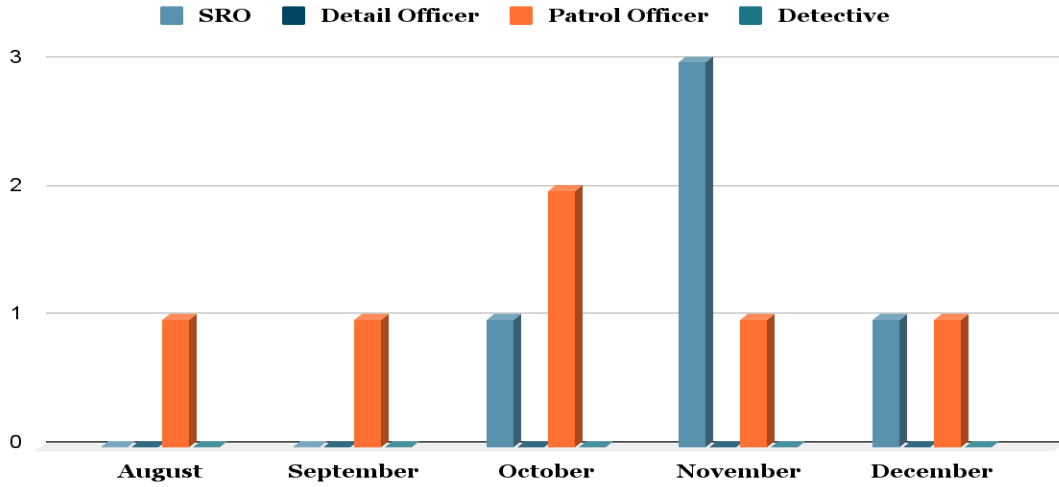

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FCHMS-Calls for Service Summary

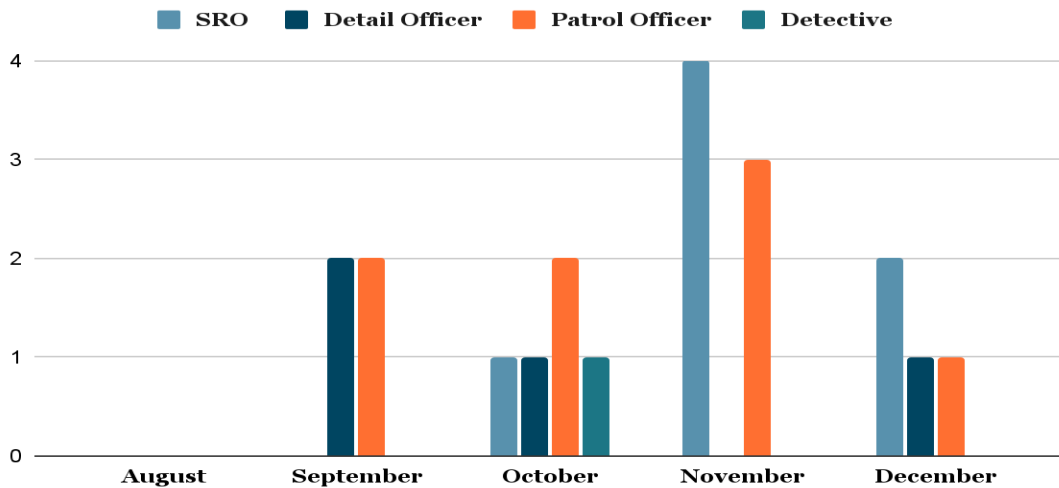


Arrests by Officer Type

There were a total of 20 arrests made during the first two quarters of the school year. The below chart breaks out arrests by month and officer type:

- August: 0 arrests
- September: 4 arrests (Patrol-2, Detail- 2)
- October: 5 arrests (Patrol-2, Detail-1, SRO-1, Detective-1)
- November: 7 arrests (Patrol-3, SRO-4)
- December: 4 arrests (Patrol-1, Detail-1, SRO-2)

Section III: VDOE School Climate Survey (High School Only)

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The Virginia School Survey of Climate and Working Conditions is currently underway for 2022. Staff and students for grades 9 through 12 were surveyed this year during the open period of February 7, 2022 to March 7, 2022. The survey results are expected to be available late April 2022. This annual survey is a component of the school safety audit which school divisions are required to submit to the Virginia Center for School and Campus Safety, according to § 22.1-279.8.B of the Code of Virginia. This survey, conducted jointly by the Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) and the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS), has not been completed since 2020.

School administrators at the SRO-assigned campuses were asked for feedback regarding the SRO's assigned to their schools. All feedback received noted SRO's were supporting schools in accordance with MOU standards. Formal performance evaluations of SRO's are completed by APD.

The School Resource Officer (SRO) program returned to Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS) in late October 2021. No formal education outreach was conducted by SRO's during the first semester of the school year as the SRO's focused on school safety and beginning the process of building new relationships with school staff and students to better understand their needs.
