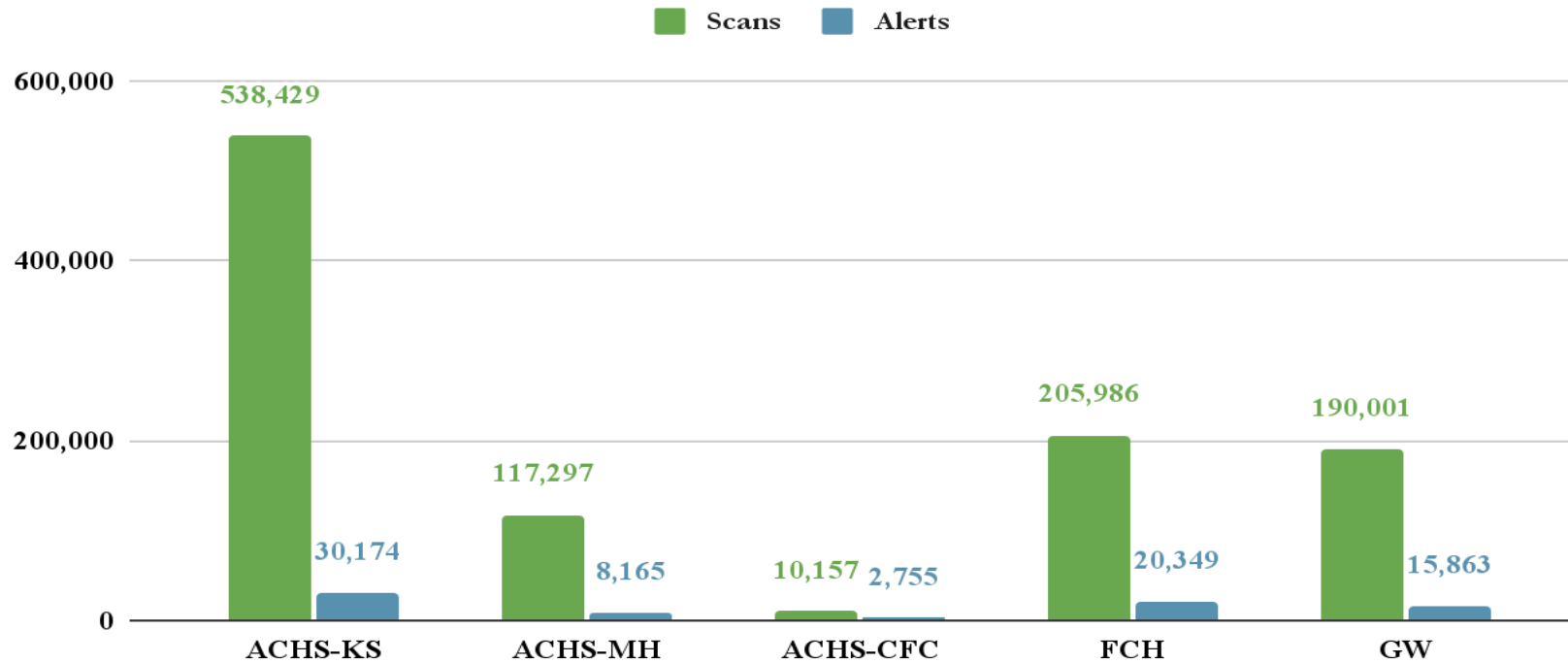
# Pilot Program Timeline

Date	Milestone
February 2023	Presented Pilot Program Recommendation to School Board
March 2023	Received Approval for Pilot Program from School Board
April 2023	Procured Equipment
May 2023	Installed Equipment at Secondary Locations
May 2023	Pilot Program Begins
June 2023	Continued Pilot Program during Summer School
August 2023-January 2024	Pilot Program Continues for First Half of SY23-24
February 2024	Update and Recommendation to School Board on Next Steps



# Metrics

## Weapons Abatement Metrics



**Note:** Metrics represented are inclusive of all weapons abatement systems used



# Weapons Incident Comparison

School Year	Quarter	Weapons Incidents
SY 21-22	1	13
SY 21-22	2	15
SY 22-23	1	15
SY 22-23	2	17
SY 23-24	1	5

There has been a **71%** reduction in weapons-related incidents between the final semester of SY 22-23 and the first semester of SY 23-24
