## **Our Changing Landscape**

#### What is new?

As of July 2022, Ready Regions help every Virginia community:

- **Be accountable.** Virginia's early education system must prepare children for success.
- **Be welcoming.** Families must be engaged in designing a system that works for them.
- Be responsive. Parents must be able to access the child care they want and need.
- **Be stable.** Early education programs need consistent supports to deliver quality services.
- **Be bold.** Every community in Virginia should be a place where families can thrive.



## Access

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#### KFY Access Committee Update: Community-wide Family Survey

Coming out of the pandemic, our committee wants to better understand the new landscape from parents' perspectives and learn how they are making choices about early care & education settings for their children.

Family input will help Alexandria's early childhood providers understand current priorities and inform future programming.

#### **COMMUNITY SURVEY GOALS/METRICS**

**Goal –** responses from 1,000 families with young children, targeting families in need of services

Duration – March 10<sup>th</sup> – April 30<sup>th</sup>

Next Steps – Expand partners and survey outreach channels, Family focus groups from survey respondents, reporting out data, informing programming






