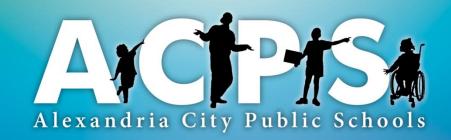

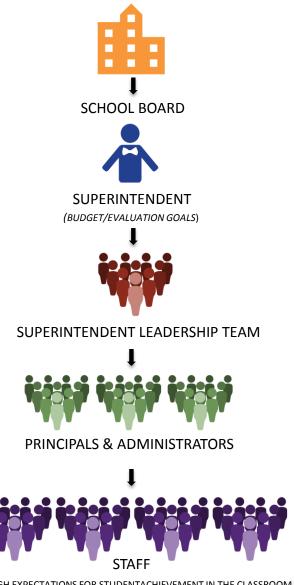

- October December 2019: Staff work collaboratively to develop Superintendent's Proposed Budget
- November December 2019: Superintendent and CFO conduct 2x2 meetings with Board members on Superintendent's Proposed Budget items
- January 2020: Budget Priorities align with the Superintendent's Proposed Budget
- June 2020: School Board adopts the Budget
- June July 2020: Staff develops Focus Areas for the coming school year
- August 2020: Schools and Departments develop Improvement Plans based on Focus Areas
