Mission Statement + Additional Questions:

The external facilitators shared the SLEP Advisory Group's mission statement:

The mission of the SLEP advisory group is to assist ACPS leadership, the Superintendent and the School Board in <u>reimagining the school law enforcement partnership</u> with the Alexandria Police Department in order to ensure a <u>positive</u>, <u>safe and equitable</u> school experience for all students.

A few questions related to the mission statement were raised for further consideration:

- Does the group have the opportunity to amend the mission statement?
- The scope seemed larger in the initial documentation shared; will the scope only have this particular focus?

The team also inquired about:

- The process the team will undergo should the board request a revision from the team,
- How the team will work with the interim superintendent
- An opportunity to further include the community's perspective (i.e., partnering with other community groups that work to solve similar issues), and
- Clarity that the team is not just responsible for revising the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).
