**SUMMARY**: The 2021-2022 Academic Calendars have been recommended by the Calendar Committee and are presented to the School Board for information. Highlights of the calendars include an earlier start to the school year for both calendars, with a first-time pre-Labor Day start for the traditional calendar. Please note that academic calendars may change due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

**BACKGROUND**: At the December 19, 2019 School Board Meeting, the Board approved the study of a pre-Labor Day start in August for the 2021-2022 Academic Calendars. A public survey on the question was completed in January 2020, and the results were reviewed and considered by the Calendar Committee. The Committee studied the question of a pre-Labor Day start in order to align the academic calendars with other divisions in the region. The Committee recommends that the School Board approve the 2021-2022 Academic Calendars in May 2020 in order for staff and families to plan accordingly for this change.

**RECOMMENDATION:** The Superintendent recommends the School Board adopt the SY 2021-2022 Academic Calendars.

**IMPACT:** Making this calendar decision this early in the process, will allow the staff to plan for changes to school programs, facilities projects and operational services. Likewise, families will be able to plan their family activities around the new start dates for the SY 2021-2022.
