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ALTERNATIVE PATHS TO ATTAINING STANDARD UNITS OF CREDIT

In order to be awarded a diploma, secondary school students are required to earn standard and 3 4 verified units of credit as specified in the regulations of the Virginia Board of Education. A "standard credit of credit" or "standard credit" is awarded for a course in which the student 5 successfully completes 140 clock hours of instruction the requirements of the course. The 6 Alexandria City School Board (Board) recognizes that instruction, learning and outcomes 7 8 equivalent to those achieved in 140 clock hours of instruction can be attained in a variety of ways. Therefore, the Board waives the requirement that a student receive 140 clock hours of instruction 9 to earn a standard unit of credit as provided below. The total number of standard credits that can 10 be achieved via the waiver option is 4. Students may earn fractional credits via the waiver. 11

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13 Waiver Options

• A maximum of four (4) standard (world language) credits can be achieved via the credit-15 by-exam option by students in grades 6-12. If successful, students will receive a "pass" 16 grade for the equivalent course(s), which will appear as a "P" on transcripts to signify the 17 levels have been successfully completed. Students will not receive a letter grade that will 18 impact their grade point average (GPA). Standard credits achieved through this option are 19 considered equal to any other standard credit in terms of class rank, grade point average, 20 extracurricular eligibility, and high school transcripts. The Board pays for the cost of the 21 examinations. 22

Pursuit of credit-by-exam by students with Individualized Education Programs and/or 504 plans
will be prescribed by the student's program/plan.

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3 Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS) complies with the Regulations Establishing Standards for 4 5 Accrediting Public Schools in Virginia, including the awarding of standard and verified units of eredit.-In order to be awarded a diploma, secondary school students are required to earn standard 6 and verified units of credit as specified in the regulations of the Virginia Board of Education. The 7 award of A "standard credit of credit" or "standard credit" is awarded for a course in which the 8 policy 9 student successfully completes for a high school course is based on 140 clock hours of instruction and completing the requirements of the course, as further detailed in Policy IKF and Regulation 10 IKF-R. However, Tthe Alexandria City School Board (Board) recognizes that instruction, learning 11 and outcomes equivalent to those achieved in 140 clock hours of instruction can be attained in a 12 variety of ways. Standard credits achieved through this 27 option are considered equal to any other standard credit in terms of class rank, grade point 28 average, extracurricular eligibility, and high school transcripts.
