School Board Election Cycle & Terms: Legal Basis and Governance Changes

Legal Basis

City of Alexandria Charter

§§ 3.01, 10.01, 15.10: Council and School Board Elections

- 3-year concurrent terms for Council Members and Mayor
- City Council elections held in November 2015; every 3 years thereafter
- School Board elections held every 3 years; coincide with Council elections

Governance Changes

City Charter amendment with revised terms for the School Board:

- Initiated by Council
- Applies to School Board, not the City Council
- Amendments to City Charter approved by General Assembly



Previous Discussions

- 2016-2018: Workshopped and passed resolution
- 2019-2021: Twice discussed then tabled during pandemic

Recently, Del. Bennet-Parker informed us that it is not a requirement for both the School Board and Council to be on the same election schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Alexandria City School Board requests that the Alexandria City Council consider exploring one or more potential amendments to its City Charter during 2018-2019 as proposed below.

The School Board further encourages the next School Board, to be elected in November 2018, to develop and present specific recommendations to City Council on the matter during 2019, and for both elected bodies to actively seek community input on the following:

- Transitioning Alexandria City School Board Member and Alexandria City Council Member terms of office from concurrent to staggered terms, and therefore the possibility of holding elections more frequently than every three years; and
- Supporting the School Board's interest in exploring a reduction from its nine-Member Board to a lesser number and to possibly include at-large Members.

Adopted at the June 21, 2018 School Board Meeting



School Board Election Cycle & Terms: Current Framework

- 3-year term begins January 1 following a November election
- 9 Board Members, 3 districts (A, B, C), 3 members each
- Board Members serve concurrent terms
- Board terms coincide with City Council terms
- 1994: First ACPS elected board; previously appointed by Council
- 2012: Elections transitioned from May to November
- Next election: November 2024


Statewide:

- > Approximately 2/3 of School Boards serve staggered terms.
- > Only 3 city School Boards in Virginia serve concurrent terms.
- > 121 School Boards serve 4-year terms.
- > 14 School Boards serve 3-year terms.
- > 1 School Board serves a 2-year term.

- **V** Public Hearing April 20, 2023
- Work Session May 18, 2023
- Adopt Resolution June 2023
- City Council drafts charter revisions Summer 2023
- Public Hearing on draft charter September/October 2023
- Draft legislation October 2023
- Insert draft legislation into School Board candidate packets January 2024
- State legislature approves charter revisions 2024 Session
- Last Concurrent Elections November 2024
