SUMMARY:

On September August 31, 2023, the Virginia Department of Education approved the new 2023 Math Standards of Learning. In response to these new standards and stakeholder requests for a comprehensive resource to help teachers address these new standards, a Request for Proposal (RFP) process began in early 2024.

DETAILS:

For the K-5 Math High-Quality Instructional Material adoption, a Request for Proposal (RFP) was released on February 8, 2024. The K-5 Math RFP was scheduled for the CIP FY25 budget as a prioritized allocation.

BOARD BRIEF

BACKGROUND:

Seven vendors have submitted eight comprehensive resources in response to this RFP. The attached document provides online access information to the resources. Due to the size of the proposal materials, the core, print instructional materials have been arranged on the 4th floor of 1340 Braddock Place.

A public review is also being conducted through April 5, 2024. Families of ACPS students and ACPS staff have been requesting and accessing online materials. They have also been accessing the full physical proposal submissions at the ACPS Warehouse located at 604 S. Pickett St. This opportunity was communicated through the ACPS Express and is also on the Instructional Materials webpage on the division website.

RECOMMENDATION: The Superintendent recommends that the School Board review the information and available materials for the K-5 Math High-Quality Instructional Material adoption.

IMPACT:

ACPS plans to purchase new K-5 Math High-Quality Instructional Materials as a result of the RFP. Funding for the textbook adoption was approved as part of the FY2025 Capital Improvement Budget in the amount of \$1,000,000. The selection committee recommendation will be presented at the May 23, 2024 School Board meeting.
