## DRAFT--Proposed Procedures for Selection of Inductees for AHOF

1. The minimum number of inductees each year is as follows:

| Pre -1965 Athlete | 1 |  |
| Post -1965 Athlete | 2 |  |
| Pre -1965 Team | 1 |  |

| Coach/Administrator/Contributor | 1 |  |

2. Screening and Voting of Candidates:
A. The Screening Committee shall review all candidates based on information available at the time.

- After open discussion about candidates, the selection committee shall call for a vote for the purpose of selecting a slate of inductees to vote upon.
- To be listed on the slate of final nominees to be voted upon, the ACPS Athletic Hall of Fame the nominee must be voted by all voting members.
- A survey will go out to the committee allowing a vote of a specified number of inductees whom they feel should be inducted into the next ACPS Athletic Hall of Fame Class.
- Every effort should be made to induct deserving candidates who are more senior in age before more recent graduates, while attempting to represent a good cross section of graduation year/age, sport, male/female in a given induction class.
- The nominees receiving the greatest number of votes will be presented to the ACPS Athletic Hall of Fame Committee for final voting.

- The voting procedure and details must be kept confidential.
B. All finalists' applications for each category shall be reviewed by the committee prior to any vote.
C. The committee shall then vote by ranking the candidates from top to bottom with the highest point value a warded to top candidate in each category.
D. The finalists in each category who are not elected will automatically be placed on the ballot the next year.
