## SCHOOL BUS SCHEDULING AND ROUTING

School bus routes shall be reviewed at reasonably frequent intervals, but at least once each year for safety hazards and fuel conservation and to assure maximumthe efficient use of buses. School administrators shall—work with the Director of Transportation to address—evaluate the safety of students at bus stops periodically, and shall—report the results to the School Board annually, eoincide with the Enrollment Report.

A written vehicular and pedestrian traffic control plan for each school shall be reviewed annually for safety hazards. All new school site plans shall include provisions that promote vehicular and pedestrian safety.
