SUMMARY:

At the January 5, 2023 School Board Organizational Meeting, the School Board adopted the 2023-2024 School Board Meeting Calendar. At that same meeting, policy BCA was amended changing the Organizational Meeting from January to July. The revised calendar updates the School Board Meeting Calendar by removing the previously approved January 2024 Organizational Meeting and adding an Organizational Meeting on July 20, 2023 in accordance with Policy BCA.

BACKGROUND:

The School Board normally meets twice per month for regular School Board Meetings and holds an Organizational School Board Meeting in order to elect the Board Chair and Vice Chair. The calendar of School Board meetings aligns with the academic calendar and allows for flexibility to add key budget dates. There is some variance in the twice monthly schedule due to alignment with religious holidays where work may be restricted.
