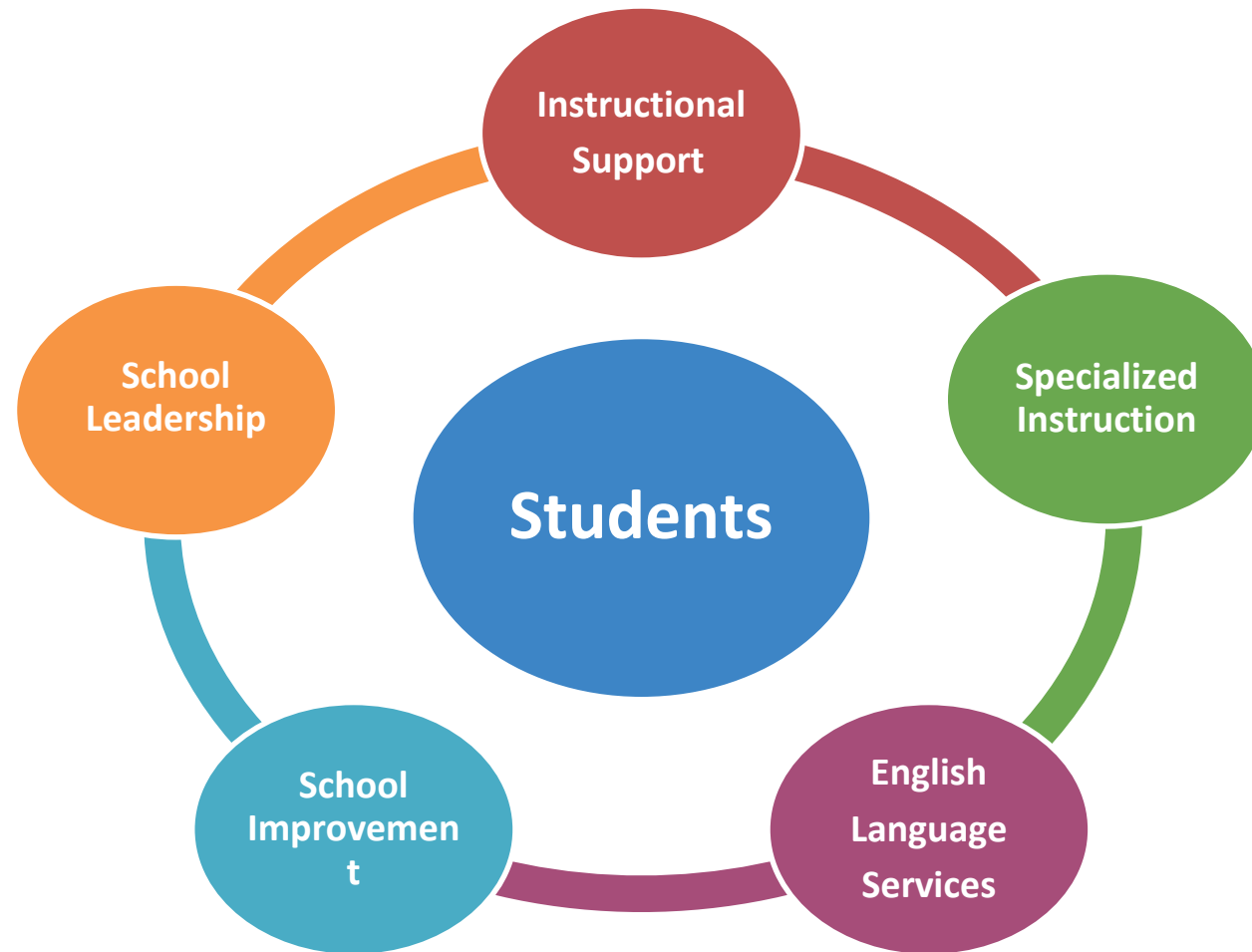

# Purpose of the Program of Studies

- Begins the **advisement period** for students and families
- Provides **guidance** for Academic and Career Planning (ACAP)
- **Outlines schedule possibilities** at all grade levels
- Links school-based learning with the **knowledge and skills** required for success in the workplace
- Offers steps for **academic and career planning** for grades 6–12; includes **course requirements and expectations**
- Defines **graduation requirements**
- Provides **information about academies** (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics [STEM]; International Academy; Health Sciences Academy; Academy of Finance )
- **Lists support offered** to students
- Provides students and families with a **list of course offerings**
