BACKGROUND: On May 5, 2021, the Alexandria City Council unanimously adopted a Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 General Fund Operating Budget of \$770.7 million, which represents increase of 2.3% over the current year. The budget approved by City Council includes a two-cent real estate tax rate reduction from \$1.13 to \$1.11 per \$100 of assessed value. The FY 2022 budget funds 100% of the Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS) School Board's approved capital improvement program and operating budget.

SUMMARY: As one of the last technical adjustment items for the FY 22 budget, City Council authorized the reallocation of contingent reserve funding for the ACPS and Northern Virginia Community College (NVCC) concurrent enrollment program (+\$400,000). The City Council Approved FY 2022 budget increased ACPS' Operating Transfer to \$239,437,296 (an +\$400,000 increase from the City Manager proposed budget) in order to support this program.

RECOMMENDATION: The Superintendent recommends that the School Board reviews the information included in the work session attachments.
