**RECREATION, PARKS & CULTURAL ACTIVITIES VIRTUAL PLUS AND AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS  
FALL 2020**

RPCA has partnered with ACPS to provide sites for vulnerable children attending Title 1 schools to have supervised classrooms during the school day and after school recreation until 5pm. Programs began at two recreation centers September 14 and additional sites and classrooms are being added as resources become available. RPCA also partners with ACPS on three 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers grants at Ferdinand T. Day and Hammond and this year with Brent Place. RPCA has two public programs (shaded in chart below) for families of essential workers with priority to those needing financial assistance at Mt. Vernon and Patrick Henry Recreation Centers and one after school program for children with disabilities at Nannie J. Lee Recreation Center.
