TOPIC: Extracurricular Activities

BACKGROUND: As ACPS expands its opportunities in athletics and student activities to an increasing number of campuses that house secondary students, Principal Balas has proposed a change in staffing to more adequately handle the day-to-day operations of athletics and student activities. This will ultimately allow for genuine strategic planning and goal setting around enhancing opportunities, increasing early Titan pride and developing more partnerships, both within Alexandria and beyond.

When the team is in place, they will have several initial actions, which include:

- Developing a strategic plan that supports ACPS 2020 and clearly outlines the parameters
 on what constitutes a sport, club, team, or activity in grades 6-12 and in alignment with
 the Virginia High School Leagues (VHSL) policies and regulations. The new athletics
 and student activities strategic plan will be drafted for presentation before the first budget
 work session for FY2020.
- Exploring how surrounding jurisdictions define teams, clubs and other student activities
- Developing parameters and guidelines that clearly define teams, clubs and other student activities and how they will be supported by ACPS.

IMPACT: The athletics and student activities office will be able to operate more effectively, including answering long standing issues on clubs, partnerships, and sportsmanship.
