SUMMARY:

This memo provides an update of Community Use of Facilities for March 2022. To provide context, non-essential use of all ACPS facilities was reinstated as of March 16, 2022. In March 2022, indoor use of our facilities included a spelling bee, RPCA youth basketball games, a Cub Scout pack meeting, a Girl Scouts meeting, a pizza and pasta fundraiser, and POD activities for AHD at Jefferson Houston and Cora Kelly. Outdoor use of our facilities included RPCA lacrosse club games, a family movie night, ASA soccer games, futsal training, track practice.

\$300.00 was collected for use of schools in March 2022.
