

2023-24 First Semester Highlights

Platform Use

- 73% students have at least one parent with access to all ParentSquare features, i.e. digital signature, form completion, etc.
- 83% school-based staff have active accounts
- 1,043 staff members and PTA leaders have shared posts
- 384 students enrolled at two or more schools/campuses;
 parents receive messages from each school/campus

System Enhancements

- Automated sync of secondary counselor caseloads
- Shift primary staff data source from Munis to PowerSchool
- 11 Webtool consent forms created by TIS

Contactability

99% students

have at least one valid contact who receives ParentSquare notifications

98% contract and casual staff have valid email addresses in ParentSquare

*Staff with invalid contact details include those who are not issued ACPS email accounts




Message Deliverability*

8,178 (42%) parents receive app notifications












Messaging Frequency











How Parents Interact on ParentSquare






Post Distribution





Direct Message Distribution








Increased Language Accessibility

Expanded Attendance Notifications

Parents/guardians are notified after the first period and at lunchtime if their student is marked absent at these points during the school day.

Parents/guardians will still receive the standard absentee notification by 6 p.m. each day if the student was reported absent from school after 2 p.m. or if attendance from earlier class periods is submitted after 2 p.m.





Support Conference Sign-Ups

2,748 secondary parents/guardians signed up for parent-teacher conferences

3,779 elementary parents/guardians signed up for parent-teacher conference





Looking Ahead

- Continued staff training and resource sharing to increase proficiency and usage of platform
 - Targeted staff engagement at secondary schools
 - Offering onsite office hours and virtual support
- Support attendance interventions by establishing templates and ParentSquare systems for sending attendance threshold letters that will increase efficiency and save time for school social workers




Looking Ahead

- Departmentalizing classes at the elementary level to expand teacher access to classrooms beyond their homerooms
- Expanding Secure Documents feature
 - 674 secure documents sent in 2023-24
 - Allows staff to securely send home important documents that contain student information including progress reports, report cards, extracurriculars, etc.



Looking Ahead

- Exploring student communication feature of ParentSquare for 2024-2025
- Secondary students
- Secure student-staff communication that students can access via email, text, web or app
