## **SUMMARY:**

On November 1, 2023, Alexandria City Public Schools received an unrestricted financial donation of \$5702.35 from Safeway Foundation as a grant from its School Spirit Education campaign.

In accordance with ACPS Policy KH and Regulation KH-R, any donation over \$2,500 requires school board approval. The donation must meet the established standards of acceptance requirements. Those standards and the appropriate responses are detailed below:

## **DETAILS:**

# **ACPS Donation Standards of Acceptance**

- 3. Place no unacceptable conditions or restrictions on the school division or its educational or extracurricular programs;

This donation places no unacceptable conditions or restrictions on the school division or its educational or extracurricular programs.

4. Not assume that the School Board will accept responsibility for continuing the benefit of or program supported by the donation if or when the funds are exhausted;

This is considered a one-time, unrestricted donation. It is assumed that the ACPS School Board will not have any further action or responsibility related to this donation.

Meet any applicable federal, state, and/or local laws and regulations, Board policies, regulations or guidelines associated with its construction or use; and meet any applicable safety standards.

This donation meets all local laws, regulations, Board policies, regulations and guidelines.

## **BACKGROUND:**

During the month of August 2023, Safeway stores in Maryland, Virginia, Delaware and Washington D.C. raised money at their cash registers to help schools for the 2023-24 school year. \$5,702.35 was raised for Alexandria City Public Schools. The Safeway Foundation supports causes that impact customers' lives, focusing on giving locally in the areas of health and human services, hunger relief, education and helping people with disabilities. These funds are unrestricted.

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Superintendent recommends that the School Board accept the donation of \$5,702.35 to help cover the division's lunch debt balance.
