BAC is a volunteer committee that advises and supports the School Board by making recommendations on policies and practices related to Alexandria City Public Schools budget. It also advises the School Board on the degree to which the budget supports best fiscal practices and the Board's priorities.

Participating in the BAC allows members to

- Gain insight into the budgetary priorities for educational programming, school staffing, building modernization, and more.
- Provide input into community engagement and communications regarding the budget.
- Offer recommendations regarding budget priorities, engagement between City and ACPS leaders, and opportunities for improving the Division's overall success.

We are looking for:

- Members from across the City of Alexandria, representing the broad diversity of communities, backgrounds, and perspectives that makes our City and Schools thrive.
- Members representing many viewpoints, including students, parents, educators and other professionals or business representatives, who can inform the school division's work.

The BAC meets once-per month at ACHS to discuss relevant issues, as well as interacts with other key community leaders and groups.
