

EQUITABLE ACCESS TO ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

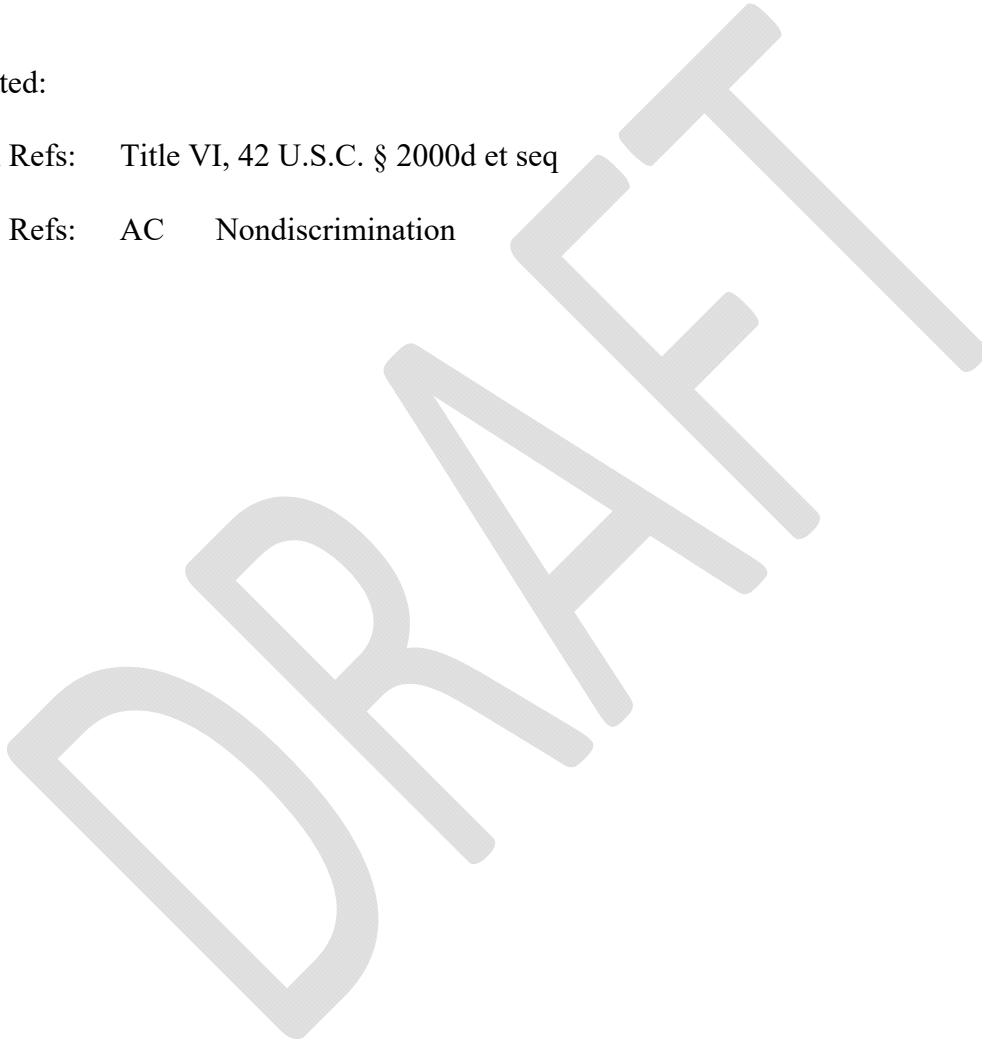
In communicating with families, school personnel respect their linguistic and cultural diversity, and differing needs. Alexandria City Public Schools (ACPS) will communicate with parents/legal guardians about program offerings and other essential information in a language they understand, including translating documents with essential information into the major Division-wide languages and providing access to quality interpretation for less commonly spoken languages.

The Superintendent will develop regulations to support the implementation of this policy.
