During home instruction, the student attendance is recorded according to regulation JEA-R Attendance Regulations.

Online Virtual Courses

Online courses can afford students the opportunity to take courses not available in their school, allow students to learn outside of the traditional school day, and help prepare them for postsecondary opportunities.
