	The selected product should deliver the following:
1	Alignment with the Virginia SOLs: The Virginia Board of Education Standards of Learning (SOL) Documents for English can be found at the link below.: http://www.doe.virginia.gov/testing/sol/standards_docs/english/index.shtml
2	Customer support for ACPS teachers and staff using contracted materials and related materials or services.
3	Authentic texts to support curricula for diverse learners
4	Integration with Clever and Canvas
5	A digital platform offering a high volume of quality electronic texts
6	Access to diverse and culturally relevant texts (including authors and characters of diverse cultural backgrounds) in both print and digital formats
7	Access to all genres of text: fiction, non-fiction, drama, essay, poem, novel, etc.
8	Core text to support literature and composition
9	Classroom libraries
10	Continual addition of new titles (updated on at least an annual basis)
11	Software that is device agnostic/compatible across operating systems: IOS, Android, PC, Chromebook, etc.
12	Access to a library of lessons and activities aligned with the VDOE SOLs with support for differentiation
13	Accessibility across home and school settings
14	Resources for vocabulary instruction
15	Resources for grammar, usage, mechanics instruction
16	Resources for genre-based writing instruction
17	Access to on-demand professional development modules
18	Access to 5-7 days per year of customized professional development and support for the duration of the contract with the option to add days after the contract.

19	Organizational and staff experience with implementing and providing support for a textbook adoption in a district with similar demographics
20	Consultants assigned to directly work on this project
21	A team of people to whom ACPS can escalate issues and a plan for resolving ongoing and significant concerns
22	Culturally Relevant/Responsive
23	Resources for language acquisition (wish list)
24	Complex texts (must have)
25	Platform with a writing resource that scores essays
26	Assessments with multiple questions on the same skill
27	Available audio for major works in English and other languages if available
28	Closed captioning (must have)
29	Access to text differentiated by various Lexile levels. (For example, the text in the textbook may be on grade level but a low and high Lexile version of the same text is available, as well.)
30	An integrated MLA style guide (kind of like the style guide in the back of "Everything's an Argument") with things like how to cite in-text sources, structure a bibliography, format an essay, etc.
