ACPS Out of School Time LINK Club Sites

NOTE: The following is to provide specific information regarding the current sites and potential vision of expansion of ACPS out of school time programming:

CURRENT:

School-based LINK Club Sites:

- 1. **Ferdinand T Day Elementary School** serves approximately 100 Ferdinand T. Day students in kindergarten through fifth grade in partnership with the City of Alexandria Department of Recreation, Parks and Cultural Activities (DRPCA).
- 2. **Francis C. Hammond Middle School** serves approximately 100 Francis C. Hammond students in grades six to eight in partnership with the City of Alexandria DRPCA.
- 3. **Jefferson Houston PreK-8 School** serves approximately 70 Jefferson-Houston students in grades two through eighth in partnership with the Alexandria Redevelopment and Housing Authority (ARHA). Preference is given to Jefferson-Houston students residing in ARHA public housing.

Community-based LINK Club Sites:

- 1. **ARHA Ruby Tucker Center** serves approximately 15 Jefferson-Houston students in kindergarten through first grade in partnership with the Alexandria Redevelopment and Housing Authority (ARHA). Preference is given to Jefferson-Houston students residing in ARHA public housing.
- 2. **Brent Place** serves approximately 40 students in kindergarten through fifth grade who reside at Brent Place. Students predominantly attend Samuel Tucker Elementary School and Patrick Henry Elementary School. The program is provided in partnership with Homes for America, the affordable housing property owner.
- 3. Community Lodgings Fifer Center serves approximately 15 students in first through second grade who attend Mount Vernon Community School and George Mason Elementary School and approximately 15 seventh and eighth grade George Washington Middle School students. The program is provided in partnership with Community Lodgings, Inc. and all students served are English learners (ELs)/Former ELs who reside in the surrounding Chirilagua neighborhood.

- 4. Community Lodgings New Brookside Center serves approximately 15 students in third grade who attend Mount Vernon Community School and George Mason Elementary School and approximately 15 sixth grade George Washington Middle School students. The program is provided in partnership with Community Lodgings, Inc. and all students served are English learners (ELs)/Former ELs who reside in the surrounding Chirilagua neighborhood.
- 5. Community Lodgings Beverly Hills Center serves approximately 15 students in grades four through five who attend Mount Vernon Community School and George Mason Elementary School and approximately 15 ninth to twelfth- grade ACHS Minnie Howard and ACHS-King Street students. The program is provided in partnership with Community Lodgings, Inc. and all students served are English learners (ELs)/Former ELs who reside in the surrounding Chirilagua neighborhood.
- 6. **Patrick Henry Recreation Center** serves approximately 30 Patrick Henry K-8 School students in kindergarten through fifth grade in partnership with the City of Alexandria DRPCA.

EXPANSION:

(Planning is in place to potentially begin at the start of school year 2022-23)

- Cora Kelly Elementary to serve approximately 90 Cora Kelly students in kindergarten through fifth grade in partnership with the City of Alexandria DRPCA.
- 2. **John Adams Elementary -** to serve approximately 75 John Adams students in kindergarten through fifth grade in partnership with the City of Alexandria DRPCA.
- 3. **William Ramsay Elementary -** to serve approximately 90 William Ramsay students in kindergarten through fifth grade in partnership with the City of Alexandria DRPCA.
- 4. **George Washington Middle Schools (GWMS) -** to serve approximately 90 GWMS students in grades six to eight in partnership with the City of Alexandria DRPCA.
